

OFFICIAL RULES

1. Patrons must be 18 years of age or older with a valid photo I.D. Patrons must be a Riverwind Wild Card member with complete and accurate information to participate. The following individuals or entities are not eligible to participate or win during this promotional activity: employees of Riverwind Casino, employees of the Nation prohibited from participating as set forth by any of the Nation's policies, regulations or laws; anyone who has been barred from any of the Nation's gaming facilities; or any promotional sponsors.

2. Winner(s) are responsible for all applicable taxes. Winners will receive a W-2-G and/or a 1099 tax form, when applicable, provided by the Chickasaw Nation.

3. Acceptance of prize constitutes winner's permission for Nation to use his/her likeness or name for publicity or promotional uses without compensation or notice. Winner must agree to sign a publicity release form before the prize will be released.

4. Any situation or dispute not covered by these Official Rules will be resolved by Nation in a manner deemed by Nation to be the fairest to all concerned. Any such decision shall be final and binding on all Patrons. In addition, Nation reserves the right to void any entry, and/or change, cancel or modify this promotion at any time without notice. Upon any prize dispute resulting from game play, participants may file a Prize Claim with the Chickasaw Nation, Office of the Gaming Commissioner.

5. Participation in this promotion is an agreement to abide by these Official Rules. Failure to comply with these Official Rules may result in disqualification from the promotion and a forfeiture of any prizes.

6. Participation in this promotion and/or tournament further constitutes the affirmative consent of each patron to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Nation, its regulatory bodies and courts without limit to time or event, which shall govern this promotion.

7. All promotions are based on participation.

8. Riverwind Casino's electronic drawing system will be sole determinate of each drawing.

9. Daily tournament registration begins one hour prior to scheduled tournament. All patrons playing in cash games one hour prior to start of registration will have buy-in preference. Daily tournaments will be capped at management discretion. Depending on the tournament, Alternates and Re-entries are allowed through the first hour or first break. Depending on the tournament, blind levels will increase every 15, 20 or 30 minutes. Any scheduled special tournament or event will discontinue all daily tournaments for that day only unless otherwise posted.

2-5 Splash (2-5 NL and 2-5 PLO Only):

Within the designated promotion times the poker room will splash the pot with \$100 on one (1) randomly drawn 2-5 NL or 2-5 Pot Limit Omaha cash game every 30 minutes. Riverwind Casino's electronic drawing system will be the sole determinate of each drawing.

• Once the table has drawn, the poker room staff will splash \$100 in chips to start the pot. The \$100 splash is considered part of the pot.

• All players dealt in the hand will be eligible to play for the splashed money plus the money that is bet for that hand.

• All players dealt in the hand will be eligible to play for the splashed money plus the money that is bet for that hand.

• Players cannot agree to split promotional winnings.

• In case of a multi player tie the money will be divided equally to the winning players. Any odd money will go to the winning player immediately left of the button.

• If promotional money is paid in chips, those chips are considered in play.

• Promotional money will roll over if there is not an eligible winner for the designated time of the drawing.

• 2-5 tables are eligible to be drawn multiple times.

High Hand:

Within the designated promotion time the poker room will log the top 3 highest hands on all open live Hold'em cash games until the beginning of the next hour. The player with the highest hand will win the designated promotion amount for that day.

• Qualified hands are defined as a Flush or better while the player using one (1) or both of their whole cards.

• Suits do not play.

• Players cannot check down their hands.

• Players cannot agree to split promotional winnings.

• In case of a multi player tie the money will be divided equally to the winning players. Any odd money will go to the winning player immediately left of the button.

• Players must play the hand to the river in order to qualify.

• Once the poker room calls for the end of the high hand hour, all hands in play will be recorded for the next high hand hour.

• Promotional money will roll over if there is not an eligible winner for the designated time of the drawing.

• If promotional money is paid in chips, those chips are considered in play.

Hot Seats:

Within the designated promotion time the poker room will randomly select one (1) active player seated from one (1) live cash game cash game every 30 minutes. Riverwind Casino's electronic drawing system will be the sole determinate of each drawing.

• Hot Seat winners will be paid in chips for the designated amount and the chips will be considered in play.

• Players must be seated and active in order to win.

• Players not at their seat at the time of the drawing are not eligible to win.

• If a randomly drawn player is not at their seat at the time of the drawing, another player will be randomly drawn.

• Players cannot agree to split promotional winnings.

• Promotional money will roll over if there is not an eligible live cash game at the designated time of the drawing.

• Players are eligible to be randomly drawn multiple times.

Tournament Buy-Ins, Structures and Fees:

• \$40 NLH Re-Buy: Tournament will have 20 minute blind levels and 2,000 starting chips. Players can pay an optional \$10 Dealer Appreciation fee for an additional 2,000 tournament chips. Unlimited Re-Buys are \$20 for 2,000 tournament chips and are allowed for the first hour anytime a player is under 2,000 tournament chips. A \$20 Add-On for 2,000 tournament chips is allowed at the first break. Alternates and unlimited Re-Entries are allowed for the first hour. Re-Entries will be placed on the Alternates list. The tournament is capped at management discretion. The Buy-In is \$40 with \$30 going to the tournament prize pool and \$10 going to the house fee.

• \$75 NLH Re-Entry: Tournament will have 20 minute blind levels and 3,000 starting chips. Players can pay an optional \$10 Dealer Appreciation fee for an additional 2,000 tournament chips. Alternates and unlimited Re-Entries are allowed for the first hour. Re-Entries will be placed on the Alternates list. The tournament is capped at management discretion. The Buy-In is \$75 with \$65 going to the tournament prize pool and \$10 going to the house fee.

• \$115 NLH Deep Stack Freeze Out: Tournament will have 20 minute blind levels and 10,000 starting chips. Players can pay an optional \$10 Dealer Appreciation fee for an additional 2,500 tournament chips. Alternates and unlimited Re-Entries are allowed for the first hour. The tournament is capped at management discretion. The Buy-In is \$115 with \$100 going to the tournament prize pool and \$15 going to the house fee.

• \$115 NLH Bounty: Tournament will have 20 minute blind levels and 5,000 starting chips. Players can pay an optional \$10 Dealer Appreciation fee for an additional 2,000 tournament chips. Bounties are \$50 per patron. Alternates and unlimited Re-Entries are allowed for the first hour. Re-Entries will be placed on the Alternates list. The tournament is capped at management discretion. The Buy-In is \$115 with \$50 going to the tournament prize pool, \$50 for bounties and \$15 going to the house fee.

• \$220 NLH Bounty: Tournament will have 20 minute blind levels and 8,000 starting chips. Players can pay an optional \$10 Dealer Appreciation fee for an additional 2,000 tournament chips. Bounties are \$100 per patron. Alternates and unlimited Re-Entries are allowed for the first hour. Re-Entries will be placed on the Alternates list. The tournament is capped at management discretion. The Buy-In is \$220 with \$100 going to the tournament prize pool, \$100 for bounties and \$20 going to the house fee.

• \$330 NLH Re-Entry: Tournament will have 30 minute blind levels and 15,000 starting chips. Players can pay an optional \$10 Dealer Appreciation fee for an additional 2,500 tournament chips. Alternates and unlimited Re-Entries are allowed for the first hour. Re-Entries will be placed on the Alternates list. The tournament is capped at management discretion. The Buy-In is \$330 with \$300 going to the tournament prize pool and \$30 going to the house fee.
