



**Kevin Fowler headlines first COOP Ale Works Beats & Bites event May 11**  
*Family-friendly event kicks off four-concert summer series*

**NORMAN, OKLAHOMA (April 22, 2019)** – Riverwind Casino’s COOP Ale Works Beats & Bites Festival kicks off its summer schedule with family-friendly fun, food trucks and a concert by Kevin Fowler on May 11.

Now in its fourth year, the Beats & Bites Festival is a free, outdoor event for families that brings together the best in music, food and fun. Each event is attended by as many as 10,000 people. It is located in the casino’s west parking lot and runs 6-10 p.m.

“Beats & Bites is a community-focused event that we take great pride in organizing and sharing with our patrons and the larger community as a whole,” said Justin Yahola, general manager of Riverwind Casino. “With a new sponsor and a terrific lineup of food trucks and performers, this first event kicks off our celebration of summer and what we hope to be one of our best Beats & Bites yet.”

The band Time Machine will open the show at 6 p.m. Fowler will take the stage at 8 p.m.

Fowler in concert is more than just a show: it’s an experience. The Amarillo, Texas, native’s wild-eyed charisma breathes new life into old favorites like “Beer, Bait and Ammo” and “The Lord Loves a Drinkin’ Man,” his twangy vocals riding atop the honky-tonk groove of his backing band.

**Family Fun**

In addition to music and food, the COOP Ale Works Beats & Bites Festival features a number of family-friendly activities and attractions, including inflatable bounce houses, face painting, games and handouts for kids, including bubble necklaces, sunglasses, slap bracelets and glow sticks; Rumble the Bison, the Oklahoma City Thunder mascot and the Thunder Girls; the OG&E ThunderBolt interactive truck and the Goldsby Fire Department.

**Food Trucks**

Mobile cuisine from across the metro area and up-and-down the I-35 corridor will be featured. Twenty-five food trucks are expected to participate, offering a range of traditional favorites to exotic dishes.

Oklahoma City-based COOP Ale Works will also have a variety of seasonal and signature craft beers on tap during the event.

Additional festival dates are June 8, July 6 and Aug. 10. The July 6 event will feature a firework show. All Beats & Bites events are free and open to the public. Future 2019 Beats & Bites events also will feature numerous food truck and merchandise vendors.
