Josh Turner – 8 p.m., Friday, Oct. 25

From his 2003 debut *Long Black Train* to his 2017 Billboard No. 1 release, *Deep South*, Josh Turner has scored multiple Grammy, CMA and ACM Awards nominations and received six Inspirational Country Music Awards. As one of the youngest members inducted into the Grand Ole Opry, Turner has sold more than 8 million units, topped more than 1.5 billion in global streaming downloads and populated the radio with such memorable hits as "Hometown Girl," "Would You Go With Me," "Your Man," "Time Is Love," "Why Don't We Just Dance" and "Long Black Train." Ron White (2 shows) - 7 p.m. & 10 p.m., Friday, Nov. 1

Comedian Ron "Tater Salad" White first rose to fame as the cigar-smoking, scotch-drinking funnyman from the *Blue Collar Comedy Tour*, but now as a chart-topping Grammy-nominated comedian and a feature film actor, Ron White has established himself as a star in his own right. He has sold over 14 million albums (solo and with the Blue Collar Comedy Tour) and has been nominated for two Grammy Awards. Jamey Johnson – 7 p.m. Friday, Nov. 2

Singer-songwriter Jamey Johnson is one of only a few people in the history of country music to win two Song of the Year Awards from both the CMA and ACM. His 2008 album, *That Lonesome Song*, was certified platinum and his 2010 double album, *The Guitar Song*, received a gold certification. He has been nominated for a Grammy Award 11 times. Jim Gaffigan is a four-time Grammy-nominated comedian, actor, writer, producer, two-time New York Times best-selling author, Emmy-winning top touring performer and multi-platinum-selling recording artist. Charlie Daniels Band – 8 p.m., Friday, Dec. 13

From his Dove Award-winning gospel albums to his genre-defining Southern rock anthems and his CMA Award-winning country hits, few artists have left a more indelible mark on America's musical landscape than Charlie Daniels. An outspoken patriot, beloved mentor to young artists and still a road warrior at age 81, Charlie has parlayed his passion for music into a multi-platinum career and a platform to support the military, underprivileged children and others in need. Styx – 7 p.m., Saturday, Dec. 14

His last album, *Set You Free*, topped the Billboard 200 (Pop Chart), a career first for Allan.
