



OFFICIAL RULES

1. No alcoholic beverages may be brought into or out of the event venue.
2. Guests 21 and over must wear a wristband to obtain an alcoholic beverage.
3. The following are prohibited: outside food, drinks, and umbrellas. Unopened water bottles are permitted.
4. All items will be searched upon entry by event security.
5. Under no circumstance will weapons (guns, knives, or any other item resembling a weapon) be permitted.
6. Service animals only.
7. Children and/or pets are not to be left unattended on premises.
8. All children under the age of 12 must wear a wristband with their guardian's contact information. Wrist bands can be obtained at the 12 & under wristband tent.
9. We reserve the right to eject any person who violates or damages event property, fighting, or disruptive behavior.
10. Dress code is enforced to maintain family atmosphere and safety.
11. We are not responsible for theft, damage, or the loss of your private property. Please report any lost or found items to the Lost & Found.
12. Guests are responsible for notifying event management immediately of any injury while on premises.
13. Problems or complaints should be directed to the event management whose decisions are final.
14. Tables and chairs cannot be reserved and must be kept in designated areas.
15. All persons must vacate the premises when required by event management and/or security.
16. No soliciting.
17. Drone usage without prior approval is not permitted on Riverwind property.
18. Rules are subject to change without notice to the public.
